In order to promote a safe environment for all children, youth, and adult participants in The Central Texas Conference, each United Methodist congregation must certify that those working with or chaperoning children and youth at another UMC church event are MinistrySafe certified in their local UMC church. This includes the five steps of MinistrySafe Compliance: 1) Application, 2) Interview, 3) Reference Checks, 4) Background Check, 5) Online Training plus a signed agreement to work in accordance with the approved MinistrySafe policy.
